The appointed HLTA will focus on supporting all pupils across the school to close the attainment gap and accelerate progress in core subjects (Reading, Writing and Mathematics). The HLTA will also have whole class teaching opportunities across the school.

You should have proven experience of working within primary schools, a HLTA qualification and have at least NVQ2 qualifications or GCSE C or above in both English and Maths.
