WORLD BOOK DAY

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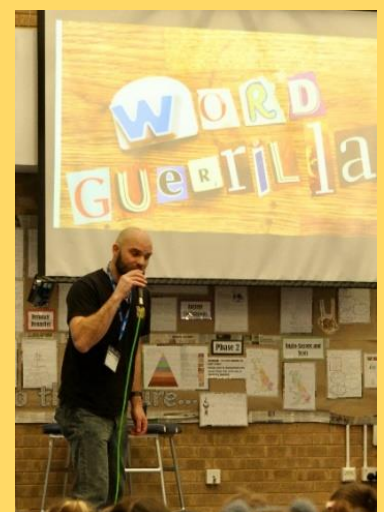

## KS2 Recommended Read

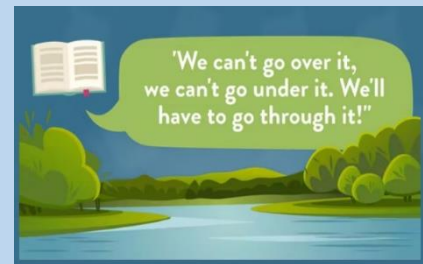
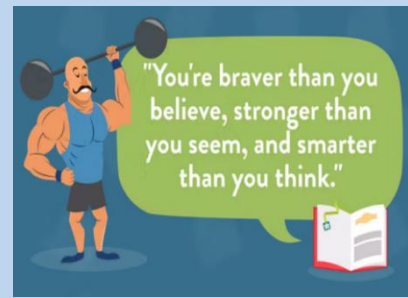
The Train to Impossible Places by PG Bell
