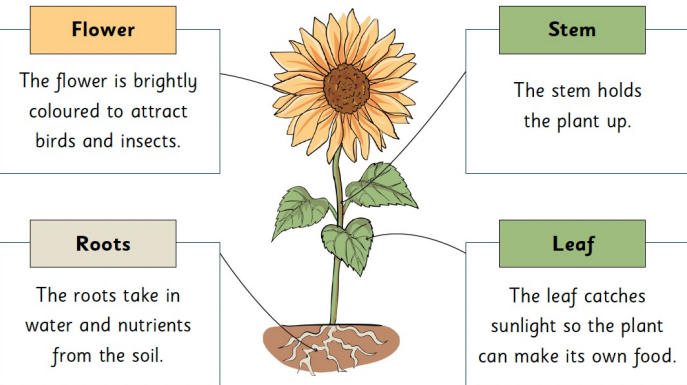


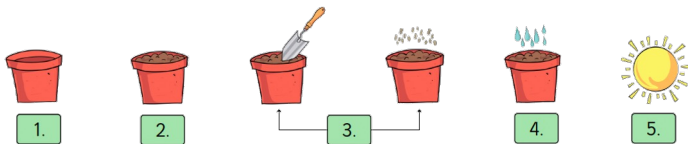
Parts of a Plant



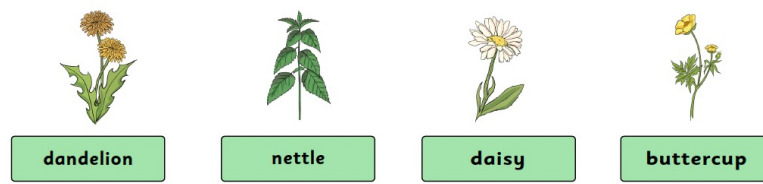
Growing Plants

We can't **make** a plant. We have to **grow** plants. Plants grow from seeds. Seeds come in all shapes and sizes.

1. First, we need a plant pot.
2. Then, we put soil in our pot.
3. Next, we make a little hole and put our seed in.
4. After that, we water the soil. Not too much!
5. Finally, we leave our pot somewhere sunny.



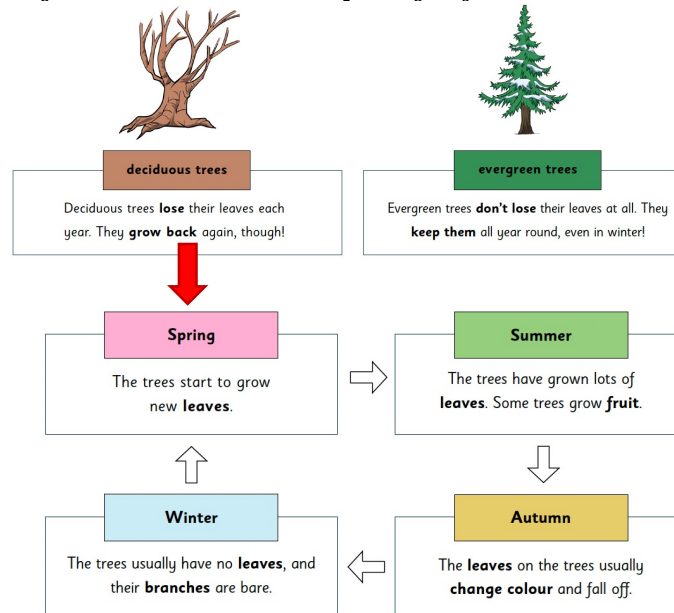
Wild Plants



Trees

Trees are plants:

- They **grow**.
- They have **roots**.
- They have **leaves**.
- Some have **flowers** and **fruits**.
- They have a big thick "**stem**" called a **trunk**.
- They have smaller **branches** and **twigs** that grow from the **trunk**.



Key Vocabulary



FLOWER: The brightly coloured part of a plant that grows at the end of a stem and only survives for a short time.



GROW: When something gets bigger and changes over a period of time.



LEAF: The part of a plant that is flat thin and usually green. Many plants lose their leaves in the winter and grow new leaves in the spring.



LIVING: Something is not dead and grows.



PLANT: A living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves and roots.



ROOTS: The part of a plant that grows under the ground.



SEED: A small, hard part of a plant that a new plant grows from.



STEM: The thin, upright part of a plant that the leaves and flowers grow on.
