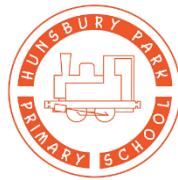


Phase 3 Curriculum Forecast

Spring Term



Writing

As writers, we will be expanding on our authorial skills by creating narratives focusing on both action and characterisation. These will be based on the text "Beowulf". There will also be opportunities to create some innovative poems.



Reading

As readers, we will be exploring "Holes" by Louis Sachar. The children will be focussing on how the setting and character create mood. The children will also explore "The way through the woods" by Rudyard Kipling.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be learning about fractions, decimals and percentages, exploring the relationship between them. The children will also learn about shape, statistics and data handling throughout the term.



Science

As scientists, we will be exploring Earth and Space as well as Animals, including humans throughout the Spring Term.



Design and Technology

As designers, we will be learning and using our woodwork skills. Here, the children will get the opportunity to explore materials and techniques before designing and making a toy.

History

As historians, we will be learning key facts and knowledge based on The Mayan. We will be exploring their ways of life, the legacy that they left and the impact that they had on society.

Geography

As geographers, we will be focussing on the polar regions. We will be looking at the wildlife that thrives, the weather conditions and comparing these to other areas of the world.

Art and Design

As artists, we will be exploring Inuit Art and how artists from that region created significant art pieces. We will be exploring artistic techniques and applying these to our work.

As sportspeople, we will be developing our cognitive skills, working on our decision making and strategy.

As responsible citizens, we will be looking at Dreams and Goals as well as Healthy Me. The children will be able to learn, share and explore their aspirations alongside learning about a healthy lifestyle.
